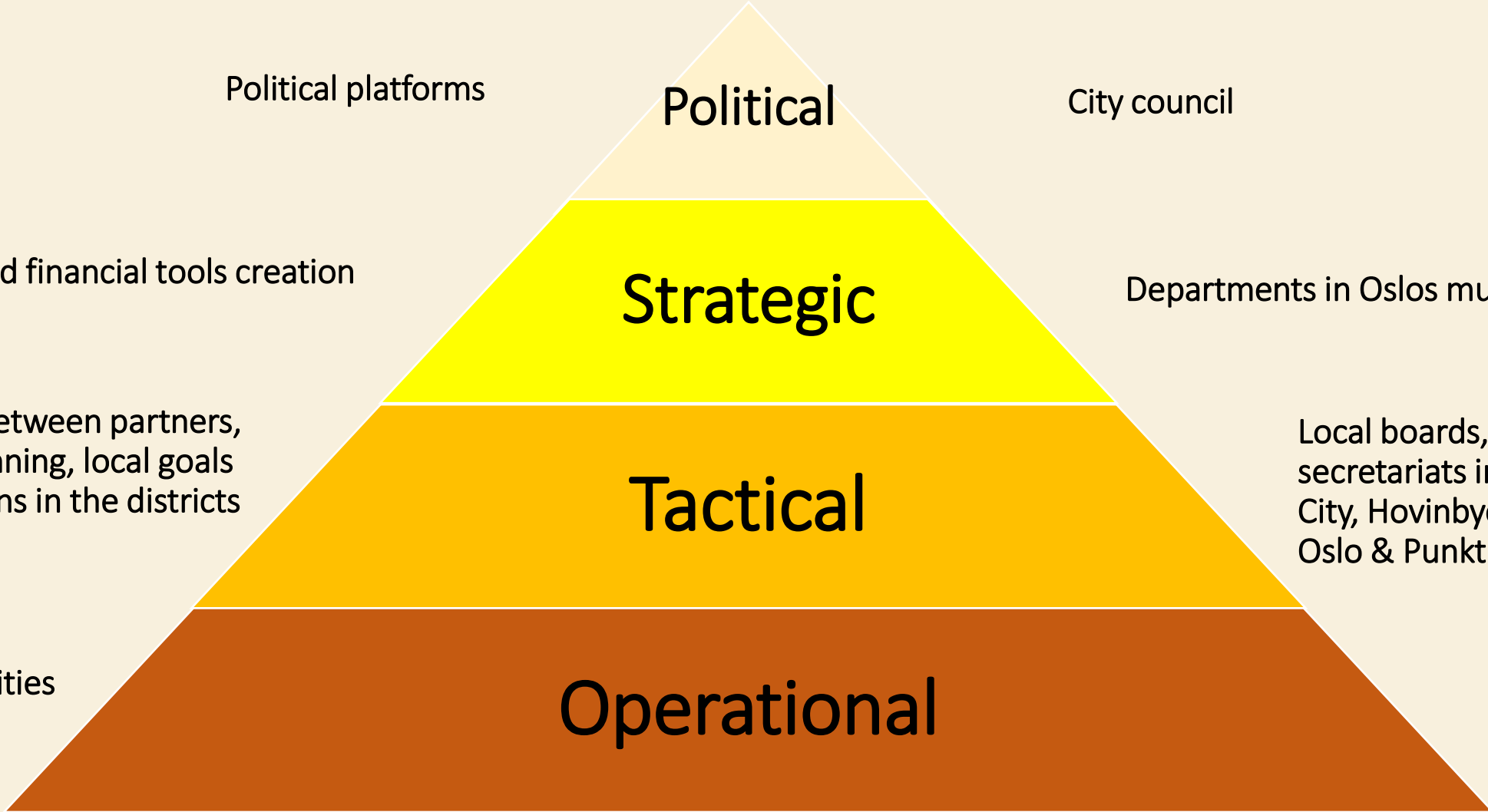

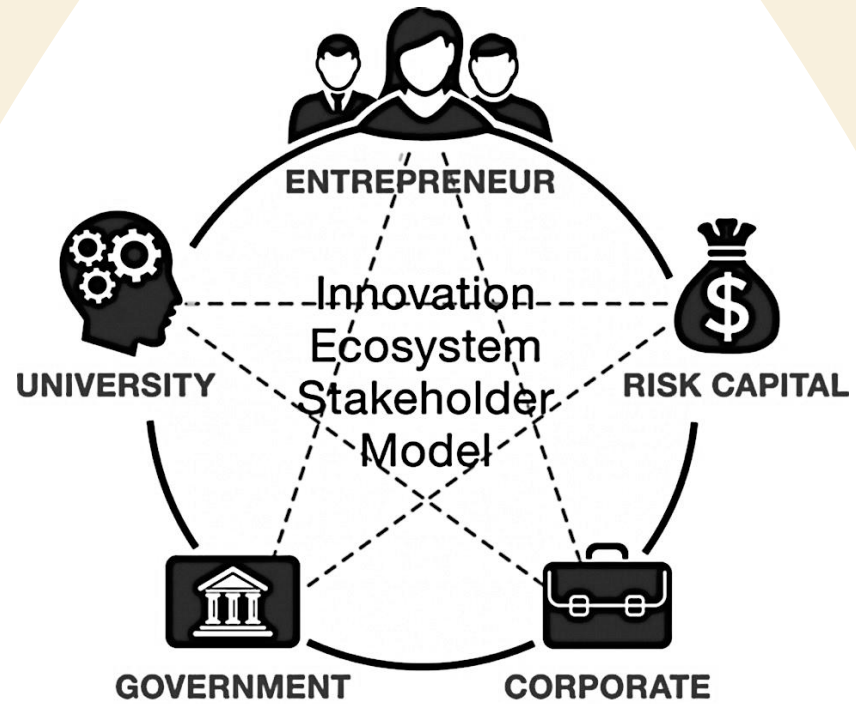

- ▶ Vision: Oslo and Akershus shall be one of the world's most sustainable, smart and innovative regions.



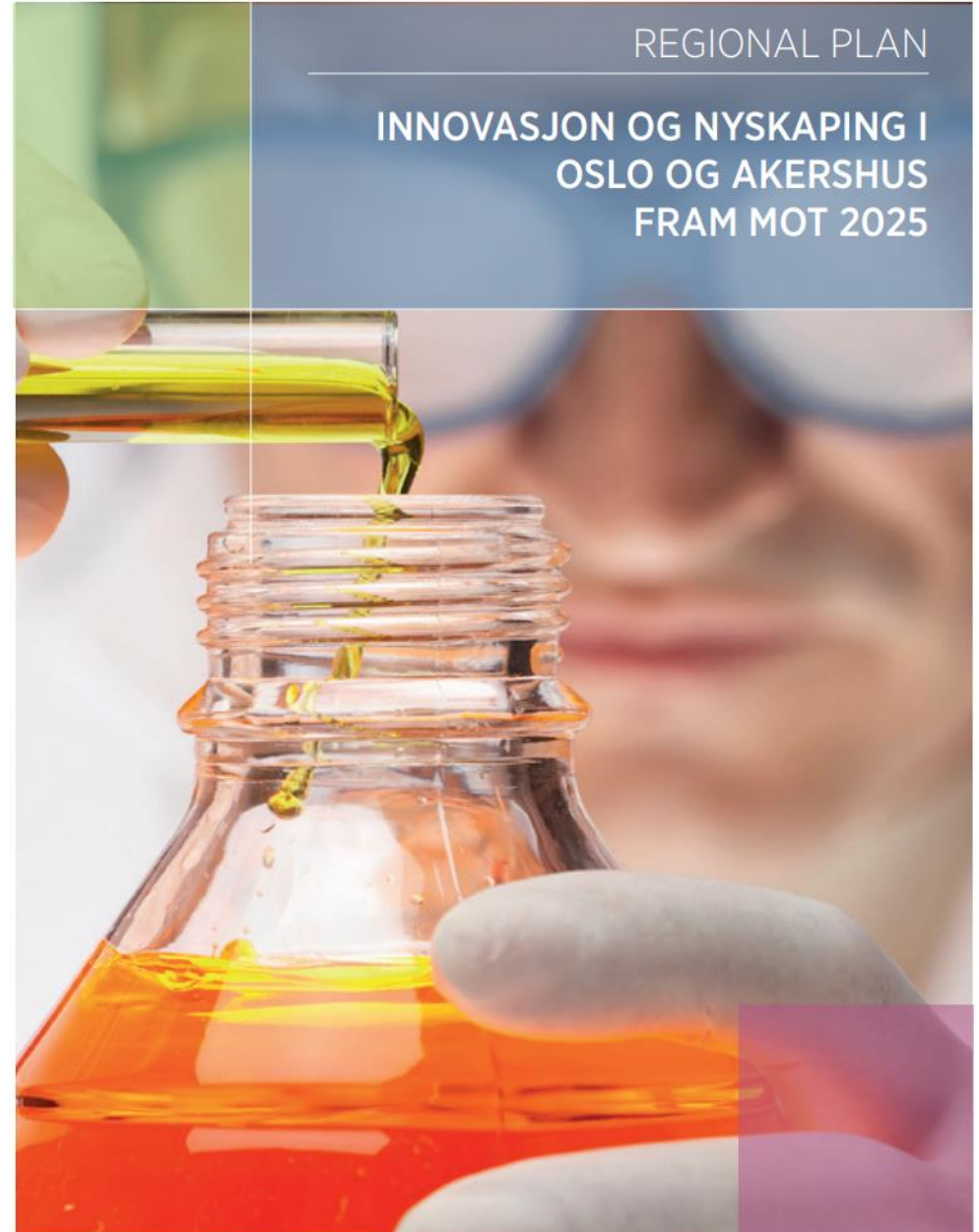

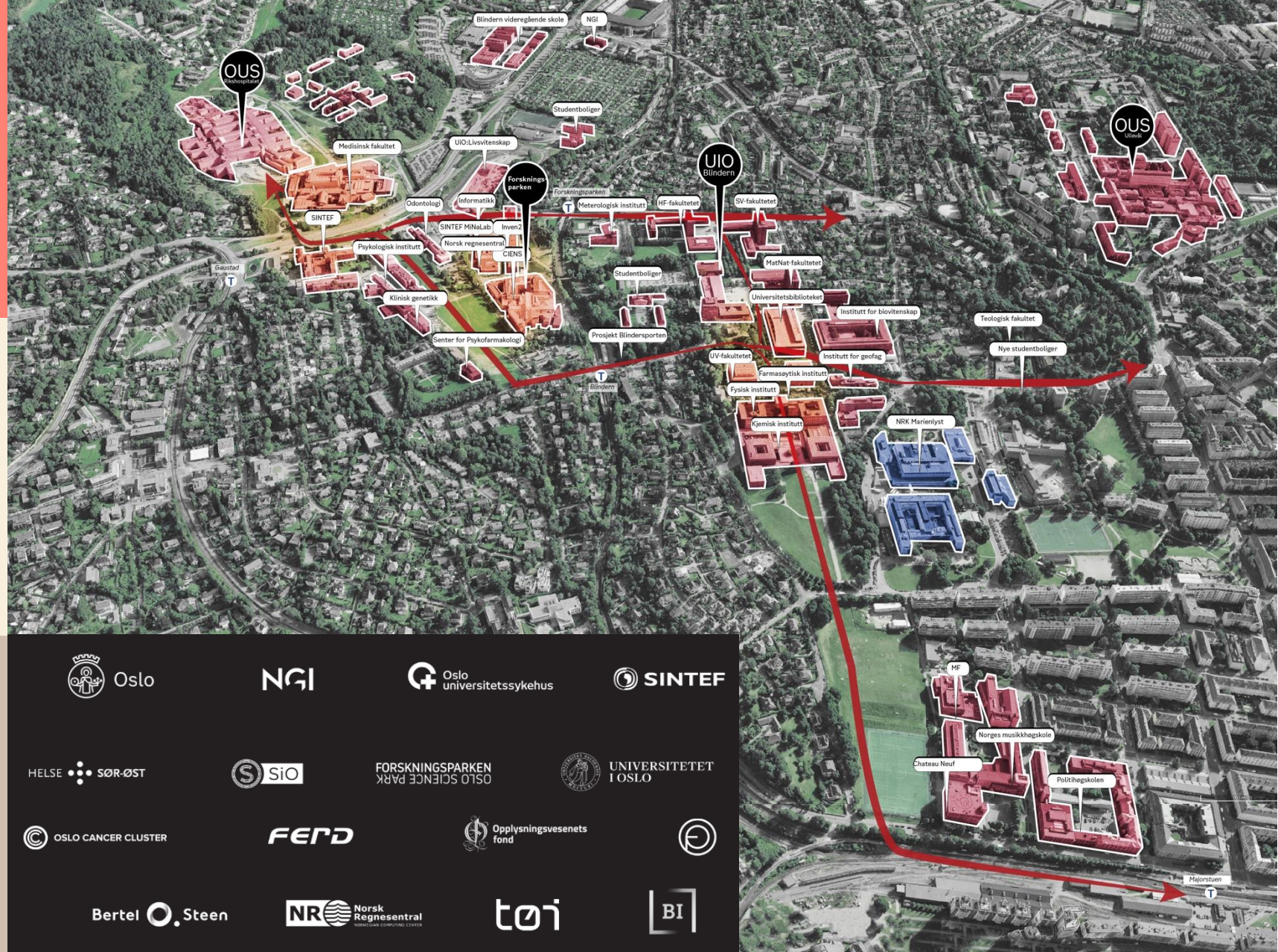

Establish innovation districts

1. Lay the foundation of use of space that makes it possible to locate business and other important functions near the city's knowledge clusters
2. Ensure good cooperation within the established innovation district
3. Support holistic development of innovation districts, based on a unified action plan across sectors and organisations
4. Utilize innovation districts as innovative areas and test arenas for new solutions and new business sectors
